

LIMITED NATIONAL INVITATION TO TENDER

Financing: MINTP Budget (Road Fund line).

The Minister for Public Works, Project Owner, hereby issues on behalf of the Republic of Cameroon, a Limited National Invitation to Tender for the execution of the above works.

1. Object:

The tender concerns the execution of routine maintenance works in the Western network, in procedure of emergency, for the 2017 Financial Year.

2. Allotment

The works shall be tendered for in one (1) lot as follows:

3. Scope of works:

The works shall involve the following tasks inter alia:

1. Borrowed backfill;
2. Excavation for pavement cleansing;
3. Scarification;
4. Patching of potholes;
5. Patching using bituminous mixture or G emulsion;
6. Patching using double dressing;
7. Isolated and grouped crack silting
8. Gravelling of shoulders with lateritic graded aggregate;
9. Planing of shoulders;
10. Foundation with natural gravel;
11. Base with natural and crutched gravel;
12. Reconstitution of the wearing course and pavement;
13. Transverse and longitudinal drainage;
14. Repair of structures;
15. Road signing and environment protection measures.

16. Eligibility:

Participation in this tender shall be open on equal conditions to the public works contractor or joint-ventures selected as a result of the Call for expression of interest No.118/ASMI/MINTP/2017 of 16 December 2017 for the above work:

17. Financing:

Works under this tender (Annual programme 2017) shall be financed by the budget of the Ministry of Public Works budget year **(Road Fund line)**.

18. Timeframe:

The overall execution timeframe shall be **08 calendar months**, with effect from the date of notification of the Notice to Proceed.

19. Contracting Authority:

After the evaluation of offers, the contract shall be signed between the Minister for Public Works, Project Owner, and the successful tenderer.

20. Provisional guarantee (bid bond):

The tender shall include for each lot a provisional guarantee (bid bond) issued in keeping with the model indicated in the tender file, by a first class banking institution approved by the Minister in charge of Finance. The amount in CFAF of the bond is specified in the table below:

The provisional guarantee of unsuccessful tenderers shall be released automatically at most thirty (30) days with effect from the expiration of the tender-validity. That of the successful tenderer shall be released as soon as the definitive guarantee shall have been constituted.

21. Consultation of tender documents:

The tender documents may be consulted during working days and hours at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public Contracts, Tenders Service, situated on the ground floor of KEANO Building, located behind the building hosting the Special Taxation Registration Unit. 22. Acquisition of tender documents:

The tender documents may be obtained during working days and hours at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public Contracts, Tenders Service, situated on the ground floor of KEANO Building, located behind the building hosting the Special Taxation Registration Unit. (See paved entrance) in Mvog Ada quarter, upon presentation of the receipt of payment into the Public Treasury of a non-refundable fee of one hundred and fifty thousand (150,000) CFA F for the purchase of the tender documents.

The said receipt must identify the payer as representing a contractor willing to participate in the tender.

23. Presentation of tenders:

The tender constituent documents shall be presented in the following three volumes enclosed in a simple envelope:

1. Envelope A containing the Administrative documents (Volume 1);
2. Envelope B containing the Technical proposal (Volume 2);
3. Envelope C containing the Financial offer (Volume 3);

All the constituent documents (envelopes A, B and C) shall be enclosed in a sealed outer envelope bearing only the subject of the tender.

The different documents of each offer shall be numbered in the order indicated in the tender and separated by dividers of same colour.

4. Submission of tenders:

Drafted in English or French and in septuplicate (7) including one original and six (6) copies, labelled as such, tenders shall be submitted, against a receipt, in a sealed envelope at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public contracts situated on the ground floor of KEANO Building, located behind the building hosting the Special Taxation Registration Unit. (see paved entrance) in Mvog Ada quarter no later than 14/06/17 at 10 a.m. They shall bear the following:

5. Tender compliance

Tenders received after the submission deadline and those not respecting the separation mode of financial offers from administrative documents and technical proposals shall be rejected.

Lest they be rejected, shall be submitted only the originals or true copies of the relevant administrative documents, certified by the issuing service, in keeping with the requirements of the Special Tender Regulation.

They must date no more than three (3) months old on the initial tender-submission deadline.

6. Opening of tenders:

The tenders shall be opened 14/06/17 at 11 a.m. in the meeting room of MINTP Tenders Board located at the Centre Regional Delegation of Public Works.

4. Tender evaluation criteria

Eliminatory criteria

- 1. Incomplete or non-compliant administrative and financial files;**
- 2. Incomplete financial file due to the absence of the following documents;**
 - A tender;
 - The price list (document 6) in keeping with the model with indications of prices exclusive of VAT in figure and words, filled in a legible manner;
 - The quantitative and cost estimate (document 7);
 - The price sub-details (document 9.9) and the decomposition of the lump sum prices and site charges.
- 3. Incomplete technical offer in the absence of one of the following elements:**
 - b1) Attestation of site visit signed by the tenderer;
 - b2) Formal declaration attesting that the bidder did not abandon a project for the last three years and that he is not in the list of failing companies drawn by MINMAP
 - b3) Methodological note (organization, planning and understanding of the project);
 - b4) Attestation of enrolment into the National Order of Civil Engineers (NOCE) for the any engineer proposed as Foreman (GCE +3 minimum) with at least five (05) years general experience in the field of road works, and at least three (03) years general experience in the field of paved road maintenance;

Not showing proof of following minimum equipment:

 - B5) A multiple wheel compactor;
 - B6) A spreader;
 - B7) A chip sealer;
 - B8) A truck of a minimum capacity of 8,000 L.
- 4. Failure by the contractor to justify his capacity to produce the bitumen**
- 5. Omission in tender financial one price unitary quantify.**
- 6. False declaration of forged documents;**
- 7. Failure to meet a total of 18 criteria out of the 24 essential criteria;**

Essential criteria

The technical proposals shall be evaluated out of 34 criteria according to the following essential criteria:

- 1. Proposed supervisory staff (item 9.5) out of 11 criteria;**
- 2. Equipment to be mobilised out of 12 criteria;**
- 3. Contractor's references (item 9.7) out of 1 criterion;**

NB: Presence of a public service employee without presentation of all documents justifying his availability notified by the Public Service;

4. Tender validity:

Tenderers shall be bound by their tenders for a period of ninety (90) days with effect from the tender-submission deadline.

5. Contract award

The contract shall be awarded to the tenderer with the lowest bid and meeting the required technical and administrative capacities.

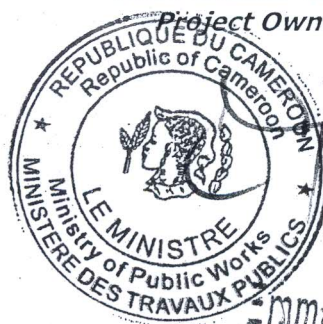
