



**OPEN NATIONAL INVITATION TO TENDER**  
**No 22 /AONO/MINTP/CMPM-TI/2016 of 23/02/2016**  
**in emergency procedure for the execution of maintenance works on certain rural roads in**  
**the Littoral Rgion (2016 Annual Programme)**

**Financing: MINTP Budget (Road Fund line for the part exclusive of taxes, PIB for the part inclusive of taxes)**

On behalf of the Government of the Republic of Cameroon, the Minister for Public Works, Project Owner, hereby issues a Limited National Invitation to tender for the execution of the above works.

**1. Object**

The tender concerns the execution of routine maintenance works on certain principal earth roads in the Western network for the year 2016.

**2. Allotment**

The works shall be tendered for in **four (4) lots** as follows:

### 3. Scope of works

These works shall involve the following tasks *inter alia*:

- Bush clearing, felling of trees and deforestation of roadsides;
- Patching of the carriageway;
- Reshaping of the platform without realignment;
- General earthworks for the punctual redevelopment of the platform, particularly raising it at flood-prone areas and enlarging the road where narrower;
- Grading compaction of the road;
- Execution of the wearing courses;
- Maintenance, repairs or creation of minor hydraulic structures such as pipe culverts, earth or paved gutters, box culverts, water pipes, earth ditches and outlets, as well as semi-permanent bridges;
- Construction of rain gates;
- Management of rain gates;
- Treatment of quagmires on the accepted road sections;
- Repairing of road signs;
- Environment protection measures.

### 4. Eligibility

Participation in this tender shall be open on equal conditions to all Cameroon-based public works contractors or joint-ventures.

### 5. Financing

Works under this tender shall be financed by the budget of the Ministry of Public Works (**Road Fund line for the part exclusive of taxes, PIB for the part inclusive of taxes**).

### 6. Timeframe

The overall execution timeframe shall be five (5) calendar months, with effect from the date of notification of the Notice to Proceed. The works shall be executed under favourable climatic conditions.

### 7. Contracting Authority

Following the evaluation of offers, the contract shall be signed between the successful tenderer and the Minister for Public Works.

### 8. Provisional guarantee (bid bond)

Each tender shall include a provisional guarantee (bid bond) issued, in keeping with the model indicated in the tender file, by a first class banking institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance and valid for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days. The amount shall stand as follows:

In the event where the consultant is tendering for many lots, he may present the two highest provisional guarantees corresponding to the lots solicited.

Lest they be rejected, shall be submitted only the original of the provisional guarantee dating less than three (3) months old.

The provisional guarantees of unsuccessful tenderers shall be released automatically at most thirty (30) days with effect from the expiration of the tender-validity. That of the successful tenderer shall be released as soon as the definitive guarantee shall have been constituted.

#### 9. Consultation of tender documents

The tender documents may be consulted at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public Contracts (Tenders Service, tel: 222 23 14 22, located in Block G by the Yaounde Municipal Lake).

#### 10. Acquisition of tender documents

The tender documents may be obtained at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public Contracts (Tenders Service, located in Block G by the Yaounde Municipal Lake, upon presentation of the receipt of payment into the Public Treasury of a non-refundable fee of **one hundred thousand (100 000) CFA F**.

The said receipt must identify the payer as representing a contractor willing to participate in the tender.

#### 11. Presentation of tenders

The tender constituent documents shall be presented in the following three volumes enclosed in a simple envelope:

- Envelope A containing the Administrative documents (Volume 1);
- Envelope B containing the Technical proposal (Volume 2);
- Envelope C containing the Financial offer (Volume 3).

All the constituent documents (envelopes A, B and C) shall be enclosed in a sealed outer envelope bearing only the subject of the tender.

The different documents of each offer shall be numbered in the order indicated in the tender and separated by dividers of the same colour other than white.

#### 12. Application deadline

Interested tenderers shall have twenty-one (21) days to apply, with effect from the date of publication of this tender.

#### 13. Submission of tenders

Drafted in English or French and in septuplicate (7) including one (1) original and six (6) copies, labelled as such, tenders shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and against a receipt at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public Contracts, Tenders Service, tel 22 23 14 22, located in Block G by the Yaounde Municipal Lake, no later than 21/03/2016 at 10 a.m. They shall bear the following:

**To be opened only at the tender-evaluation session.”**

#### 14. Tender compliance

Tenders received after the submission deadline and those not respecting the separation mode of the financial offer from the administrative documents and technical proposal shall be rejected.

Lest they be rejected, shall be submitted only the originals or true copies of the relevant administrative documents, certified by the issuing service, in keeping with the requirements of the Special Tenders Regulation.

They must date no more than three (3) months old on the initial tender-submission deadline.

## 15. Opening of tenders

Tenders shall be opened on 21/03/2016 at 11 a.m, in the meeting room of the MINTP Infrastructural Projects Tenders Board.

Tenders shall be opened once and in three stages:

- Stage 1: Opening of envelope A containing the administrative documents (volume 1);
- Stage 2: Opening of envelope B containing the technical proposals (volume 2);
- Stage 3: Opening of envelope C containing the financial offers (volume 3).

All tenderers may attend the opening session or each have themselves represented by one duly mandated person of their choice (even in the event of a joint-venture) with sound knowledge of their file.

## 16. Tender evaluation criteria

### 16.1 *Eliminatory criteria*

a) Incomplete administrative file for the absence of:

- Attestation of non-indebtedness;
- Attestation of non-bankruptcy;
- Attestation of non-exclusion from public contracts;
- Social Insurance Fund;
- The tender;
- Receipt of payment of the tender fee;
- Attestation of bank account

b) Incomplete technical file for the absence of:

- Attestation of site visit;
- Foreman with the qualification provided for in the tender file;
- A technical note on organization and methodology;
- Incomplete technical file for the absence of:

c) Incomplete financial file for the absence of:

- A tender;
- A price list (document 6) following the model with indication of prices, exclusive of VAT in figures and in words, filled in a legible manner;
- The quantitative and cost estimate of works (document 7);
- The price sub-detail (document 9) and the decomposition of all-inclusive prices and site charges.

d) Failure to meet the reference essential criterion;

e) Failure to meet at least 20 out of the 28 essential criteria.

### ***Essential criteria***

The technical proposals shall be evaluated out of **28** criteria according to the following essential criteria:

- a) Supervisory staff proposed (document 9.5) out of **11 criteria**;
- b) Equipment to be mobilised out of **16 criteria**;
- c) Contractor's references(document 9.7) out of **1 criterion**.

## 17. Tender validity

Tenderers shall be bound by their tenders for a period of ninety (90) days with effect from the tender-submission deadline.

## 18. Contract award

The contract shall be awarded to the tenderer with the lowest bid and having the relevant technical and administrative capacities.

A tenderer may be awarded a maximum of one (1) lot.

The Project Owner reserves the right not to award the contract of this tender to a consultant under the following conditions:

- If he is a holder of an on-going contract with MINTP with less satisfactory performances (formal warning whose evaluation is deemed not satisfactory or establishment of shortcomings notified within six months preceding the award or contract under termination);

- If his responsibility plan is high;
- If the result of the eventual verification of the effective availability of the equipment by the Project Owner is not conclusive.
