The Minister for Public Works, Project Owner, hereby issues an Open National Invitation to Tender for the above works.

1. Object

The works concern the execution of the rehabilitation works of the Woutchaba-Mbea-Tikondji-Nbargue road in Lom et Djerem Division.

2. Allotment

The works shall be tendered for in one (1) lots as follows:

3. Scope of works

The works shall comprise the following tasks inter alia:

- Clearing;
- Deforestation;
- Felling of trees;
- Backfill;
- Reshaping of the platform;
- Creation of ditches and diverging earth;
- Creation of outlets;
- Supply ane laying of metal culverts;
- Masonry sumps for culvert;
- Masonry culvert head;
- Enrockments;
- Masonry and stone abutments;
- D semi-permanent decks;
- Masonry facings;
- Etc.

4. Eligibility

Participation in this tender shall be open on equal conditions to all Cameroon-based public works contractors.

5. Financing

Works under this tender shall be financed by the budget of the Ministry of Public Works for the 2016 Financial Year, line: 36 467 03 22 00 21 22 50.

6. Timeframe

The overall execution timeframe shall be 5 calendar months, with effect from the date of notification of the Notice to Proceed.

7. Contracting Authority

Following the evaluation of offers, the contract shall be signed between the successful tenderer and the Minister for Public Works.

8. Provisional guarantee (bid bond)

Tenders shall include a provisional guarantee (bid bond) issued, in keeping with the model indicated in the tender file, by a first class banking institution approved by the Minister in charge of finance and valid for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days. The amount shall stand as follows:

Lest they be rejected, shall be submitted only the original of the provisional guarantee dating less than three (3) months old.

The provisional guarantees of unsuccessful tenderers shall be released automatically at most thirsty (30) days with effect from the expiration of the tender-validity. That of the successful tenderer shall be released as soon as the definitive guarantee shall have been constituted.

9. Consultation of tender documents

The tender documents may be consulted at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public Contracts (Tenders Service, tel: 222 23 14 22, Block G by the Yaounde Municipal Lake).

10. Acquisition of tender documents

The tender documents may be obtained at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public Contracts, Tenders Service, Block G by the Yaounde Municipal Lake, upon presentation of the receipt of payment into the **Public Treasury** of a non-refundable fee of **two hundred thousand (200 000) CFA F.**

The said receipt must identify the payer as representing a contractor willing to participate in the tender.

11. Presentation of tenders

The tender constituent documents shall be presented in the following three volumes enclosed in a simple envelope:

- Envelope A containing the Administrative documents (Volume 1);
- Envelope B containing the Technical proposal (Volume 2);
- Envelope C containing the Financial offer (Volume 3).

All the constituent documents (envelopes A, B and C) shall be enclosed in a sealed outer envelope bearing only the subject of the tender.

The different documents of each offer shall be numbered in the order indicated in the tender and separated by dividers of the same colour other than white.

12. Application deadline

Interested tenderers shall have twenty-one (21) days to apply, with effect from the date of publication of the tender.

13. Submission of tenders

Drafted in English or French and in septuplicate (7) including one (1) original and six (6) copies, labelled as such, tenders shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and against a receipt at the MINTP Sub-Department of Public Contracts, Tenders Service, Block G by the Yaounde Municipal Lake, no later than <u>1/09/2016</u> at 10 a.m. They shall bear the following:

14. Tender compliance

Tenders received after the submission deadline and those not respecting the separation mode of the financial offer from the administrative documents and technical proposal shall be rejected. Lest they be rejected, shall be submitted only the originals or true copies of the relevant administrative documents, certified by the issuing service, in keeping with the requirements of the Special Tenders Regulation.

They must date no more than three (3) months old on the initial tender-submission deadline.

15. Opening of tenders

Tenders shall be opened on <u>1/09/2016</u> at 11 a.m, in the meeting room of the MINTP Infrastructural Projects Tenders Board.

Tenders shall be opened once and in three stages:

- Stage 1: Opening of envelope A containing the administrative documents (volume 1);
- Stage 2: Opening of envelope B containing the technical proposals (volume 2);
- Stage 3: Opening of envelope C containing the financial offers (volume 3).

All tenderers may attend the opening session or each have themselves represented by one duly mandated person of their choice (even in the event of a joint-venture) with sound knowledge of their file.

16. Tender evaluation criteria

Eliminatory criteria

- a) Incomplete administrative file due to the absence of a relevant document;
- b) Incomplete technical file due to the absence of the following documents:
 - > Attestation of site visit duly signed by the tenderer;
 - > A foreman with the relevant qualification (document 3);
 - A note on methodology and organization.
- c) Incomplete financial offer due to the absence of the following documents:
 - Stamped tender;
 - ➢ Price list (document 6);
 - ➢ Quantified unit price;
 - > Quantified unit price sub-detail;
- d) False declaration;
- e) Failure to meet at least a total of 20 out of the 28 essential criteria;

Essential criteria

The technical proposals shall be evaluated out of 27 criteria according to the following essential criteria:

- a) Supervisory staff proposed (document 9.5) out of 11 criteria;
- b) Equipment to be mobilised out of 16 criteria;
- c) Contractor's references (document 9.7) out of 1 criterion.

NB: Any public agent listed among the staff and who has not presented all the documents likely to justify his liberation from the Public Service shall not be considered.

17. Tender validity

Tenderers shall be bound by their tenders for a period of ninety (90) days with effect from

the tender-submission deadline.

18. Contract award

The contract shall be awarded to the tenderer with the lowest bid and having the relevant technical and administrative capacities.

The Project Owner reserves the right not to award this contract to a consultant under the following conditions:

- If he has a tied programme;
- If the result of the verification of the effective availability of the equipment by the Project Owner is not conclusive.
